Preparing and Distributing Annual Crime Reports

The preparation of Southwestern's annual security report is an ongoing process. Statistics are compiled in accordance with the Uniform Crime Reporting System of the Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The annual crime report statistics are based on Campus Security Incident Reports and LAPD published crime data. To comply with the Jeanne Clery Campus Safety Act, Southwestern collects relevant online crime statistics from the City of Los Angeles for locations that are contiguous to or adjacent to the property of Southwestern.

An email notification is sent annually to all faculty, staff, and enrolled students, including a link to access this report. A copy of this report may also be obtained at the Administrative Services Office.

Unfounded Crimes

Reporting Locations

Public Property: All public property, including thoroughfares, streets, sidewalks, and parking facilities, that are within the campus, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus.

On-Campus Student Housing: Any student housing facility that is owned or controlled by the institution, or is located on property that is owned or controlled by the institution, and is within the reasonably contiguous geographic area that makes up the campus is considered an on-campus student housing facility.
