A. Introduction

Faculty typically review final examinations with students upon individual student request. All written examinations will indicate raw points for each question and the total raw points earned. Students should be aware that the faculty may change grades only as provided in the Grade Change section of the Grading and Scholastic Honors Policy. The purpose of the review is solely to enhance the student's education.

B. Grades Below C+

A student with a grade of C or below is entitled to an individual conference with the faculty member to determine the causes of the student's poor performance. This conference should not be construed as an opportunity to dispute the grade assigned.

C. Grades of C+ and Above

Individual conferences with faculty are not expected, but some feedback is appropriate for students with grades of C+ or above. Faculty members may devise their own methods to provide such feedback.
